## **Inclusion in Practice: SEND Systems That Stand Up to Inspection**

Ofsted's 2025 inspection framework grades Inclusion as its own evaluation area. At the same time, SEND reform proposals signal updated expectations for mainstream settings and changes to the SEND Code of Practice and legal requirements. This half day turns those expectations into practical systems and day to day practice.
